WHEREAS, NCT9-1-1 has complied with State regulations regarding contract and procurement proceedings.

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RESOLUTION AMENDING THE USE OF FUNDS POLICY FIN 3.1

WHEREAS, NCTCOG management staff recommend modifying the language within the second priority within the Use of Funds policy to reflect "a 10% of annual revenue budget "reserve" in operating or unrestricted fund balance".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. The NCT9-1-1 Board of Managers approves an amendment to the second priority of use of available fund balance within the Use of Funds Policy to reflect "a 10% of annual revenue budget "reserve" in Operating or unrestricted fund balance"

Section 2. The remaining policy to be unchanged from current Board approved form.
